- ➤ A full refund, less a processing fee will be made if management is notified before 6 p.m. October 24, 2017. After this date, a refund, less processing fee will be made only if that spot can be filled. A \$25 non-refundable processing fee will be charged for all distances.
- Send correct fee along with entry form, copy of current year Coggins report (dated 2017), rabies certificate from your veterinarian (within last 12 months of event date) directly to the Ride Secretary.
- > As always, Ride/Drive Management reserves the right to accept or reject any entry at their discretion.
- > All checks must be made payable to the New Jersey Trail Ride Association.

## The Jersey Devil

ALL RIDERS, DRIVERS & PASSENGERS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR A PROTECTIVE, ASTM/SEI CERTIFIED, EQUESTRIAN HELMET MEETING STANDARD F11.63, WITH FASTENED CHIN STRAP, THROUGHOUT THE RIDE.

**COMPETITIVE TRAIL RIDE (CTR):** The **Open** division will consist of all riders age 18 or over as of January 1, 2017. The **Junior** division will consist of all riders 17 years of age and under as of January 1, 2017. Riders 11 and under **MUST** have a sponsor from the open division and their applications MUST be mailed together. The junior and sponsor MUST ride together throughout the ride. If the sponsor is withdrawn from the ride, the junior must withdraw unless a replacement from the open division is found. If the junior is withdrawn, the sponsor may continue.

**COMPETITIVE TRAIL DRIVE( CTD):** The Drive will have one division that will include both singles and pairs. Junior drivers will be permitted in accordance with ECTRA guidelines. Juniors under 14 years of age MUST be accompanied by an adult over 18 years of age from start to finish.

**COMPETITIVE TRAIL RIDE PASS/FAIL (CTR P/F):** Any one electing to ride Pass/Fail will be judged as one division. Be familiar with the rules for Pass/Fail as outlined in the ECTRA Rulebook.

**CONDITIONING DISTANCE RIDE (CDR) 10 & 15 MILE DISTANCES: NJTRA** chooses not to offer CDR's with a Pass/Fail option. Please be familiar with the rules for CDR's as outlined in the ECTRA Rulebook.

**ACKNOWLEDGEMENT:** An acknowledgment of each entry will be either emailed or mailed within two weeks of receipt by the event secretary. If you would like an electronic acknowledgment, please provide your e-mail address on the entry form.

**WAITING LIST:** A waiting list is maintained for all events as required. If your entry is placed on the waiting list, you will be moved into the event as space permits. Your entry fee will be deposited upon receipt with the entire amount refunded if you cannot be placed in the event.

**CHILDREN AND PETS:** NJTRA encourages family participation at all events. A parent, guardian or baby-sitter **MUST** supervise junior competitors and children of competitors at all times. Pets must be on a leash or confined by some other means. Make sure you have proof of rabies with you for your pets. If your pet becomes a nuisance, you may be asked to leave. Anyone wishing to volunteer can contact the ride manager, Amber Benjamin, 570 507-3276.

**ARRIVAL:** We do offer camping the night before the ride and if possible we will vet horses in the night before. If you plan on arriving on the morning of the day of the ride you must be on the grounds no later than 7:30 a.m. This includes those riding 15 miles. Those riding 10 miles must be there no later than 10 a.m.

**JUDGING**: We will designate a specific area for judging. We will try to vet in horses the night before the ride up The exams will begin at daylight each morning (approx. 6:45 a.m.). You must be on the grounds of the ride site by **7:30 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday** and make yourself available for judging. This is the requirement for all distances except the 10 & 15 Mile CDRs. We recognize the process is a waiting game but if all horses are near the judging area, we can keep things moving. Bring a few bites of hay and a small bucket of water, share with a friend, make a friend and stay close to the judging area so the judges never have to wait for horses to show up for judging. **Please note 10 & 15 Mile Riders may arrive by 10:00 with judging at 10:30 a.m.**

**RIDE BRIEFING**: This will be held on each day of the ride. You will be notified by ride management as to the time of the meeting. A rider briefing for the 10 Mile Rides will be done as soon as all horses are vetted in.

**GROUNDS/CAMPING:** The ride is based out of BBB Gun Club. Parking is on a large sandy lot. Please see parking officer upon arriving. Water is available at the gun club and usually a water wagon in the back. There are flush toilets & showers in the gun club. Electric fences or picketing between trailers can be set up. The NJTRA board strongly advises that your paddocks top electric tape be about nose height to your horse (about 4 feet). Inadequate horsemanship in stabling has lead to several instances of loose horses in past years. Management reserves the right to ask any rider to leave without entry fee refund if proper stabling is not maintained.

Corral panels are available for rent at \$10/panel [each 12' long x 5' high]. We have limited number of panels so if you need them reserve them early. Please submit the Corral Panel Rental form, with payment in full, to the Ride Secretary. Corral set-up is rider's responsibility. Horses may arrive any time after 1 p.m. on Friday and must be off the grounds by Sunday afternoon.

**DIRECTIONS TO RIDE SITE**: BBB Gun Club, 180 City Line Rd, Pemberton, NJ 08015 DO NOT FOLLOW GPS COORDINATES

**From the West**: Take the route of your choice (ie Rtes. 206, 295 etc) to Route 70 E and head East to the junctions of Rtes. 70 & 72. This is called the Four Mile Circle. From the circle, continue on Rte. 70 E for approx 6.5 miles and turn right to Pasadena Road (please use only this road to enter). Mile Marker 32.5

You will now be on dirt roads. Go straight for 2 miles. You will be driving between the cranberry bogs—enjoy the view!!! Confidence markers will be posted. This road intersects with City Line Road (street sign); turn right and travel 1 mile to BBB Gun Club on the right

**From the East**: Take the route of your choice (ie Rte. 9, Garden State Pkwy, etc.) to Rte. 70 W and head West to the junction of Rtes. 70, 530 & 539 (Exxon, Wawa & traffic light). From the junction continue West on Rte. 70 for approximately 6 miles and turn left to Pasadena Road (please use only this road to enter). Mile Marker 32.5

You will now be on dirt roads. Go straight for 2 miles. You will be driving between the cranberry bogs—enjoy the view!!! Confidence markers will be posted. This road intersects with City Line Road (street sign); turn right and travel 1 mile to BBB Gun Club on the right.

**TRAIL**: The trails are in the Brendan Byrne State Forest. They are mostly dirt roads with some deep sand.

**MEALS:** Continental breakfast, on trail snacks, drinks and light lunch will be provided Saturday and Sunday for riders/drivers of all distances. Dinner will be served so that you can grab a meal after vetting and taking care of your horse. Meals for additional members of the rider's party may be purchased for \$10.00. Please submit the Extra Meals Order Form with payment in full to the Ride Secretary. Please note, we feed volunteers! If a member of your party is willing to volunteer please contact the Ride Manager, Amber Benjamin, 570 507-3276.

Friday night – Pot Luck Dinner. NJTRA will provide something.

Riders should bring something to share.

**AWARDS**: Completion awards will be given for all horses successfully completing their mileage and being judged as Fit to Continue. Placement ribbons and prizes will be given in the CTR and CTD Open and Junior Divisions for each distance 50 & 25, Breed, Rookie Rider & Horse and other special categories for awards will be made at the discretion of ride management.

**COMPLETION TIMES**: CTR & CTD – 25 miles – 4 hours and 20 minutes to 4 hours and 50 minutes.(30

minute hold)

CDR & CDD – 10 Miles – 1 hour 30 minutes to 2 hours.

CDR & CDD - 15 Miles - 2 hours 15 minutes to 2 hours and 45 minutes

ECTRA rules permit a 30 minute additional window in arriving early or later than the established ride times. For the CTR & CTD, points up to 30 are taken off for such time. In the P/F CTR, CDR & CDD, you are still entitled to Pass if the shortened or lengthened time is used.
